HOURS OF WORK: 7:00 am to 3:00 pm, Monday through Friday. On-call/Stand-by may be a requirement of this position.

DUTIES:

- Carry out all manual tasks associated with wastewater collection system maintenance including clearing of blockages, inspection, repairs and installation of associated structures and piping.
- Operation of the sewer flusher/vacuum in the cleaning/clearing of sanitary and storm collection infrastructure.
- Remove obstacles hazardous to employees or the public or that interfere with the safe operation of vehicles or equipment.
- Complete daily activity time cards, infrastructure inspection and sewer block reports accurately and completely.
- Immediately report vandalism, mechanical difficulties and damage.
- Comply with all Federal, Provincial and City regulations, policies and procedures and requirements of the Occupational Health and Safety Act.
- Acting as call out Lead Hand may be a requirement of this position.
- Perform other related duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Experience related to the duties listed above, normally acquired through completion of a Grade 12 Diploma and 1 2 years experience operating tools and equipment relevant to sewer maintenance and drainage activities. Candidates with an equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered.
- Must currently possess MOE Operator in Training Certification for Wastewater Collection. Must successfully complete Level 1 MOE certification in Wastewater Collection, within 15 months of hire date.
- Must possess a valid 'DZ' drivers licence or be able to obtain within 30 days from start date in the position and have a good driving record.
- Knowledge of wastewater collection systems and knowledge of sewer maintenance activities.
- Able to perform physical requirements of position (e.g. lifting, bending, work in confined spaces and in all types of weather conditions).
- Must be able to deal with the public in a cordial manner and have good communication skills.
- Must have the ability to operate a variety of small tools and equipment.
- Must be a reliable self-starter able to work alone and/or with supervision.
- Familiar with equipment used in sewer excavations, maintenance and cleaning.
