DUTIES:

- Install all new appurtenances in the City's Water Distribution System, as required.
- Responds to water distribution calls and provides advice to customers in a cordial and professional manner.
- Maintain and repair all equipment in Waterworks Division operation.
- Perform all manual tasks assigned and assist in equipment operation as required.
- Safely operate and perform routine daily maintenance and minor repairs to assigned equipment as required by the Operator Manual.
- Complete daily activity card(s).
- Comply with all Federal, Provincial and City regulations, policies and procedures.
- Comply with the regulations and requirements of the Occupational Health and Safety Act.
- Immediately report vandalism, mechanical difficulties, damage etc.
- Perform other related duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Experience related to the duties listed above, normally acquired through the completion of a Grade 12 Diploma and 2 years post secondary education in engineering, environmental science or a related discipline and 6-12 months experience in water or working with equipment and performing maintenance related duties. Candidates with equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered.
- Must have in your possession Operator in Training license for Water Distribution & Supply Subsystem and must pass Class 1 MOE certification exams for Water Distribution & Supply Subsystem within fifteen months of commencement in the position.
- Must possess a valid 'DZ' drivers licence or be able to obtain within 30 days from start date in the position and have a good driving record.
- Knowledge of water distribution operations and Ministry of the Environment.
- Knowledge of WHMIS and the Occupational Health and Safety Act.
- Able to perform physical requirements of position (e.g. lift objects of 25 kg, work in confined spaces and in all types of weather conditions).
- Must be a team player with good interpersonal skills.
- Good verbal and written communication skills and excellent interpersonal skills.
- Intermediate skills with Microsoft Office (Word and Excel).
- Ability to keep accurate records.
- Must be neat in appearance and have the ability to deal with the public in a cordial manner.
- Ability to use small tools and equipment.

- Experience with GIS (Geographical Information Systems) and Computer Maintenance Management Systems would be an asset.
- Experience with water main/sewer installations maintenance and repairs would be an asset.
